Mildura is home to tremendous innovation, which has often gone unnoticed. We produce a bewildering amount of wine for domestic and international consumption.

In addition, over the last 20 years we have developed the most original of all wine shows, 'The Australian Alternative Varieties Wine Show', one dedicated entirely to the emerging "new" varieties – new here, very old in Europe, Italy in particular.

When it comes to the wine offerings of a restaurant in Mildura, the question then is: where do we start? Do we go international? Do we stock premium quality with a sprinkling of cheapies to fit all budgets? Italians only? Or a mixture of everything?

Over 25 years, I have played with all these different combinations, only to find that no approach makes me as excited as I'd like to be. Now I want you to experience this wine-work in progress, which is Mildura, and note with me the changes that are happening.

So, this is what I have decided to do: I offer you some local wines the team and I deem interesting enough and good matches to our simple Italian fare.

As well as wines made by friends who have a long association with Stefano's Restaurant.

Next, in a separate list, we pair an Italian-made variety with the same variety grown in Australia, thus showing you how the world of wine in Australia is expanding choice for you, the drinker.

That is by no means an exhausting list: it is just like a photo of one moment in time which is bound to change and develop further. It is a work in constant motion.

Finally, we offer a few classics, because we know that some of you cannot do without your chardonnay or shiraz, but whilst we love all that, our food is not always at home with those marvellous and expensive varieties. But the choice is always yours!

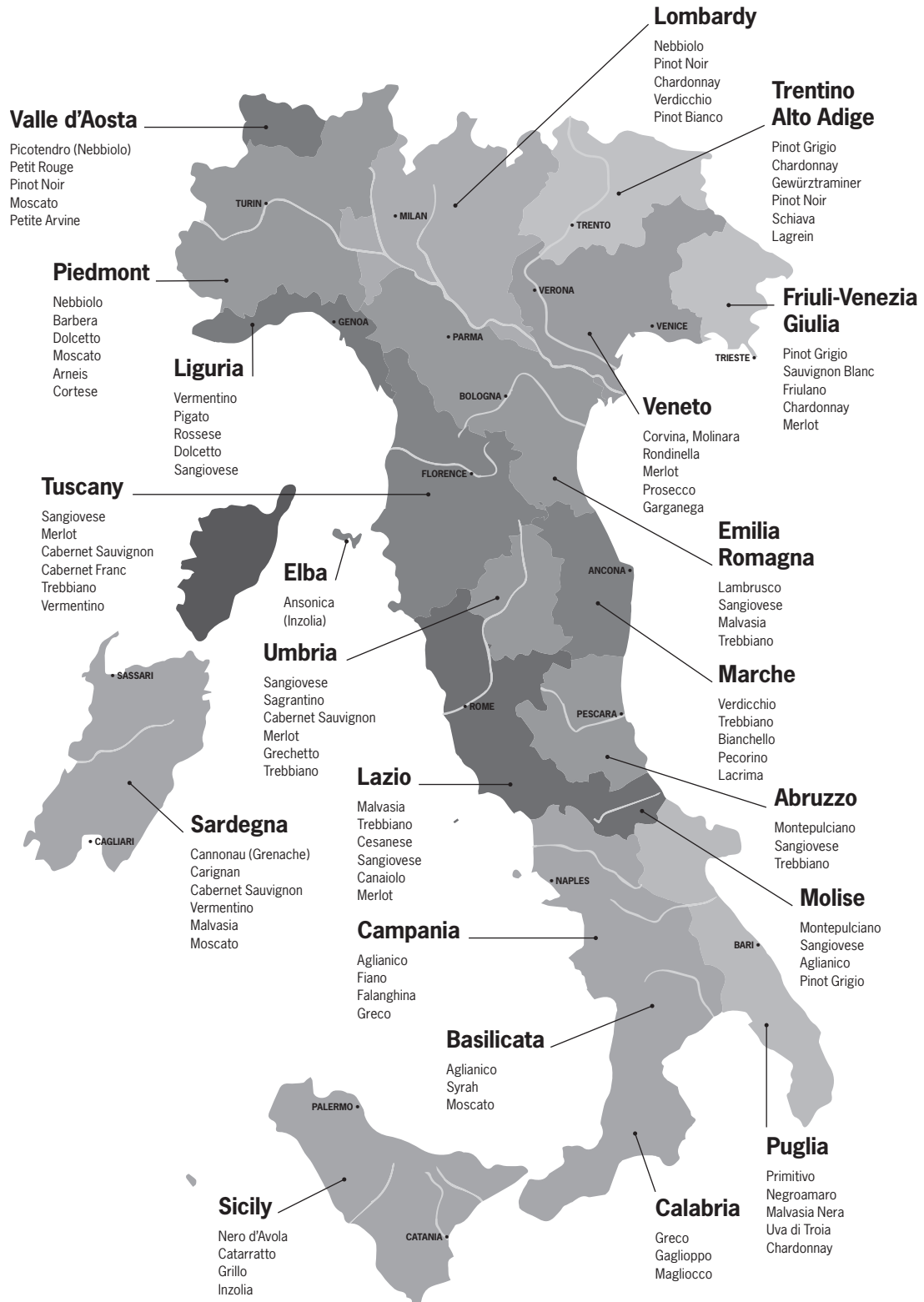
SOME FUN FACTS

LOCALS AND FRIENDS

NV STEFANO DE PIERI Prosecco | King Valley, Vic \$45

Made by my friend and colleague Sally Blackwell from fruit grown in the King Valley, this is a fresh and happy sparkling that could even accompany your entire dinner. Yes, in Valdobbiadene, near Venice, prosecco's spiritual home, they drink it with any food: in fact, they start drinking it with little appetizers from 10am and finish with dinner late in the evening.

2015 CHALMERS Lambrusco | Heathcote, Vic \$60

Made from Lambrusco Maestri, a variety increasingly used to add colour and depth to red wine, this is, I believe, the first Australian made authentic lambrusco. It is NOT sweet. It is the perfect accompaniment to Parma prosciutto and naughty fried pastries.

2016 TINO, I LOVE YOU Vermentino | Merbein, Vic \$55

This is a local vermentino, a variety from (mostly) Sardinia, grown and made in Mildura. It is a one-off. And, I love it! It was aged in a very large new chestnut 1000 litre botte (barrel) which subsequently hosted red wine. It acquired colour and texture by extracting the new wood character. The botte was made in Conegliano, near Venice, where I first attended wine school. I turned out to be a hopeless, rebellious student, but never lost my passion for wine.

2015 TRENTHAM ESTATE Verdejo | Trentham Cliffs, NSW \$45

This is a distinct variety grown in the Rueda region of Spain, north west of Madrid. Grown in Mildura, it shows pale straw colour with fresh aromas of citrus. A terrific summer wine.

2016 QUEALY Pinot Grigio | Mornington, Vic \$55

This is made by old friends and pioneers of pinot grigio in the Mornington Peninsula. They are grigio gurus. You are in safe hands. Sometimes, for some of their wines, they source grapes here in Mildura. Just think this: only 20 years ago, no one made Australian pinot grigio / gris.

2016 L'ENOLOGA Fiano | Merbein, Vic \$55

Enologa means "female oenologist". Elizabeth Richardson sources local grapes and plays with them in a rather modern fashion, in a boutique context, if you like. Fiano is native of the region of Campania, near Naples, and it shows... goes with anything!

2015 CHALMERS Greco | Heathcote, Vic \$65

Like the Fiano above, Greco is also native of Southern Italy. In this case the grapes are from Heathcote, but the Chalmers live and work here and make many wines for this restaurant.

2016 STEFANO DE PIERI	Rosé Buronga, NSW	\$38
<p>This is a Mildura sangiovese based, juicy rosé, suitable for almost anything. In the old days, there was only one type of 'sangio' from California available to us. It is a vigorous and high yielding clone, so have to bunch trim quite a lot. We pick for the rosé first and then we leave some to ripen further to go into a fuller body red.</p>		
2008 ROBINVALE ESTATE	Kerner, Organic Robinvale, Vic	\$55
<p>This is an intriguing Riesling-like wine. It was developed in Germany and it is name after a writer and poet Justinus Kerner. In 1929, August Herold crossed trollinger, a red variety known also as schiava, with riesling. And here we are, celebrating a German poet in Robinvale! How beautiful.</p>		
2013 MCGUIGAN 'THE SHORT LIST'	Chardonnay Adelaide Hills, SA	\$65
<p>The McGuigan brothers are a big part of our local wine industry and produce wines from many regions. You may encounter Neil in our restaurant spruiking wines to international buyers.</p>		
2013 CHARTERIS 'ASTRAL VINEYARD'	Chardonnay Central Otago, NZ	\$95
<p>PJ became a good friend when he was working at Lindemans in the '90's. He eventually went onto Penfolds in the Barossa and Brokenwood in the Hunter. In 2008, he established a vineyard in Central Otago.</p>		
2015 KERKARABOO	Riesling Clare Valley, SA	\$45
<p>Friends Graeme and Kristy have family here in Mildura, like many identities in the Australian Wine Industry. Graeme is Stefano's Viticulturalist.</p>		
2015 VIGNA BOTTIN	Nero d'Avola McLaren Vale, SA	\$60
<p>Or simply Nero. Avola is a Sicilian town where it gets really hot. This variety is very fruity as you'd expect from a vine used to the sun. Nevertheless, this has character and finesse, showing amarena cherries and chocolate flavours. The Bottins are my friends and I admire them for their devotion to alternative varieties. And if you are a shiraz aficionado, this wine is more your style.</p>		
2015 PASSING CLOUDS	Pinot Noir Macedon, Vic	\$70
2015 PASSING CLOUDS	Shiraz Cabernet Macedon, Vic	\$70
<p>The legendary Leith Family and Stefano have been friends for years. There is a photo of Graeme Leith in this restaurant. Now Cameron, his son, has taken over the winery and is providing splendid wines.</p>		
2014 ZORAH 'KARASI'	Areni Noir Armenia	\$95
<p>Zorik Gharibian was a fashion guy from Milano with a vineyard dream. His fantasy to him back to his country, Armenia. He planted 15 hectares of vines, areni noir, the top native red grape. Karasi means from amphora, a reference to this wine's long aging in traditional large clay amphore. His wine maker is Alberto Antonini, who has consulted widely here in Mildura on Italian varieties and is a great friend of this restaurant.</p>		

2013 **L'UNICO** Sangiovese Cabernet | Barossa Valley, SA; Mildura, Vic \$55

This is 60% Mildura sangiovese from my brother in law's vineyard. The rest is Clare Cab Sav and a very, very dark 10% lagrein from Barossa. Lagrein grows very dark here in Australia and gives plenty of backbone to any blend. This is the one for pasta with chicken livers, or grilled polenta, braised onions and duck liver.

2015 **BEACH ROAD** Aglianico | McLaren Vale, SA \$85

Another 'enologa' who used to come to this restaurant when she was young, sniffing around for unusual tipples. Briony Hoare makes this variety in the McLaren Vale. An elegant red, with good structure and length. I am fond of aglianico because it is grown in two southern Italian areas where the other half of my family comes from.

2015 **MY OTHER 'TINO** Sagrantino | Merbein, Vic \$65

Sagrantino di Montefalco in Umbria is a significant red with pronounced tannins. It will have a great future in Australia – at least according to guru Chester Osborne, who said this much to the British press. These sagrantino grapes are grown by a local family in Heathcote, but made here. It was aged in wood for a while and then "rested" in steel before bottling. Ideal with red meat and porchetta but also robust pastas.

2015 **NURSERY RIDGE** Petit Verdot | Red Cliffs, Vic \$55

A small winery from Red Cliffs. This is a big red, unashamedly big. This wine demands meat in any form. It shows spices, especially clove.

2014 **BULLER WINES BEVERFORD** Durif | Swan Hill, Vic \$40

Normally, in Rutherglen, this powerful wine is made to last decades – and it needs time to develop. In our region, the Buller family makes a version which is structured, juicy, flavoursome, generous and abundant without spilling its guts. Good almost with anything, even just by itself!

2015 **STEFANO DE PIERI** Moscato | Mildura, Vic GLASS \$10

This is one of the first moscato out of this region. It reminds me of the fragrance of panettone and other treats around Christmas in Italy. It is low alcohol, of course, refreshing and morish.

2013 **TRENTHAM ESTATE** Noble Taminga | Trentham Cliffs, NSW GLASS \$13

Taminga was developed by CSIRO when it had a branch here in Mildura closed down by the ex- minister Kim Carr – I'll never forgive him for that! Grapes are left on the vine until, around the month of May, botrytis sets in. It is a fulsome sweet wine ideal for any dessert and unique to this area.

2009 **PASSITO DI STEFANO** Malvasia Istriana and Picolit Passito | Merbein, Vic GLASS \$13

My first offering of Malvasia from Istria, in standard savoury style, made a lot of people take notice of wines other than the traditional Oz whites. In dried up style, together with Picolit, a rare variety from Friuli, it makes a delicate floral dessert wine which for me can also be taken as a generic pre or after dinner drink. I could not resist drying it on the same racks that in the past were used to dry sultana grapes to concentrate the flavour intensity. This wine is a labour of love: it has been ageing since 2009. It is a steal.

THE STORY OF AUSTRALIAN ALTERNATIVE VARIETIES

In 1999, Bruce and Jenny Chalmers, Stefano de Pieri and the late Rod Bonfiglioli established the Australian Alternative Varieties Wine Show to monitor and evaluate the gradual development of 'new to Australia' wines made from European grape varieties. This expansion has seen a steady transformation of the wine we drink and the food that accompanies it. In 1999 there was no Pinot Grigio or Gris grown in this country at all! Now the Show does not accept any Pinot Grigio/Gris entries as it is now considered a mainstream variety. All of this in less than 20 years.

Each November young sommeliers, wine makers and wine critics converge on Mildura to assess and judge over 700 entries of wines made from new varieties which are literally establishing their roots in Australila.
